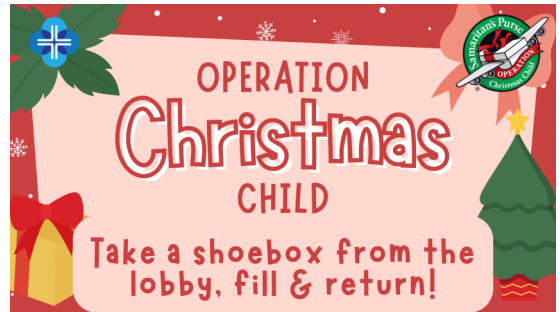
Happening today at Faith
